CONSTITUTION

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- *Beacon Hill Rovers Football Club strives to provide access for a wide spectrum of the local community to take part in football activities.
- *We adhere to the principle of equal opportunities and have adopted the F.A.'s Child Protection Policy.
- *We recognise the importance of the provision of coaching that is available to all irrespective of ability.
- *We encourage members to take up opportunities to become qualified coaches.
- *Whilst taking part in competitive fixtures we value the ethic of fair play.
- * The Club shall follow the rules and regulations of the Essex County F.A. and all competitions entered.

Membership

Beacon Hill Rovers Football Club comprises of members who contribute both on and off the field of play. Membership is available to all that follow the Club's Aims and Objectives and maintain appropriate fees. The Club will publicise its activities on a regular basis to encourage membership. For it's members the Football Club will provide facilities for training, competitive and non-competitive fixtures and community based social activities.

Annual General Meeting

This shall be held at the end of every playing season with at least one month's written notice to all members and a public notification. The AGM will comprise:

1. Attendance register and apologies for absence
2. Review and approval of the previous AGM's minutes
3. Chairman's Report
4. Secretary's Report
5. Treasurer's Report and acceptance of the audited accounts
6. Election of Officers: President, Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, a Manager for each team and three player's representatives. Only current members are eligible to vote. No one person can hold more than one of the roles of Chairman, Secretary or Treasurer.
7. Any Other Business.

Management Committee

A Management Committee will supervise the regular affairs of the Club. This Committee will comprise the Officers elected at the AGM, will meet monthly and will set the date for the AGM. The Committee's decisions shall be governed by adherence to the Club's Aims and Objectives. The Committee shall ratify all expenditure in excess of £50 prior to payment. The signatories for the Club's Bank Account shall be the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. Two signatures are required for each cheque. Should the Club fold then any remaining funds shall be passed to the Essex County F.A. Benevolent Fund.
